TUITION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

A child's parent, teacher, guardian, or mentor may recommend the child to receive a tuition scholarship to attend Summer Art Camp. Children must be 6-12 years of age to be eligible for a scholarship, and must have a real interest in art. Scholarships are awarded based on applicants' statements and the ability of funds on a first-come, first-serve basis. A \$35 deposit is due regardless of the type of scholarship for which you are applying. Partial scholarships cover the balance. Full scholarships are limited, and may cover 1-5 weeks of summer camp, depending on fund availability and the number of requests.
