Zentangle, a 'no mistakes' art method, is an easy-to-learn, fun, relaxing way to create beautiful images by drawing structured patterns found in our daily lives. Inspired by the ancient mandalas (circular art form), explore a calming rhythm as you ink 'one-stroke-at-a-time', add shading and hints of color on white Zendalas, round paper tiles, Gently guided through the core 8-steps of Zentangle, allow yourself to slowly unwind, to focus on the process and perhaps, to rekindle your creative flow.
