ArtZone Rules

Parents/Guardians and Teens should both read the following ArtZone rules carefully.

In order to keep the ArtZone a fun and safe creative space for all visitors, Gadsden Arts staff will give 2 warnings for visitors who do not follow the ArtZone rules before asking them to leave. Staff will give warnings for disruptive behavior, unsupervised children, abuse of materials or equipment, safety concerns, or other actions that could negatively impact everyone's experience in the ArtZone.

1. Safety first! All participants will follow instruction from ArtZone staff regarding safety, proper use of materials, following directions, and maintaining a clean studio for all visitors. Please report all spills or messes to an ArtZone staff member immediately.
2. Do not run. Please always walk in the studio and pay attention to where you are walking.
3. No food or drinks are allowed in the ArtZone, except bottled water.
4. Always return art supplies to their original location and respect the supply limits. All art supplies must remain in the ArtZone and cannot be taken into the galleries.
5. Always clean up your area when you're finished; if needed ask an ArtZone staff member for assistance.
6. Artwork may be taken home or left in the ArtZone on the magnetic wall galleries for display. Artwork may not be taken into the galleries. Please label all artwork with your name and date on the back if left in the ArtZone. All artworks left at Gadsden Arts for more than one week (unless otherwise specified) becomes property of Gadsden Arts, Inc. We may display the art or dispose of it as exhibit and storage space fills.
7. Be courteous to your fellow artists. Talk with your fellow artist and share ideas. However, please also be respectful to those who wish to work on their own.
