A pysanka (*plural:pysanky*) is a Ukrainian Easter Egg created using a very meticulous wax resist method. I was introduced to the art of decorating eggs over 25 years ago and have found the beauty of pysanky is that each egg tells a different story through decorative symbols. The fragility and uniqueness of each egg also add to its splendor. A pysanky makes the perfect addition to any holiday or year-round display.

Throughout the years, I have also created numerous oil and acrylic paintings focused mainly on portraits and pets. You can also find a few of my murals throughout South Georgia and North Florida. I have shared my knowledge of both painting and pysanky art through instructing small classes and exhibiting my pieces in local art shows.
