A Tallahassee native, Eluster began painting as a child and has won numerous awards for his paintings and has exhibited in a variety of museums and galleries, collected by museums such as Custom House Museum in Clarkesville Tenn., Polk County Museum of Art in Lakeland Fl. and the Riley House Museum/Center here in Tallahassee.

Public Collections includes All Children's Hospital in St. Petersburg, Fl., Florida League of Cities here in Tallahassee, Leon County Libraries here in Tallahassee, just to name a few. There are also many private collectors from around the country. Eluster is the Artist-In-Residence for the Riley House Museum and Resource Center.

His fascination with history, particularly the people and places of North Florida has resulted in a body of work that is treasured by history and art lovers of the region.
