Ann Robinson is a South Georgia/North Florida native living in Tallahassee. She was inspired as a child during summer vacations at Fernandina Beach with rich visual experiences on the marshes and on the beach. A favorite pastime was roaming the sloughs for marine life and peering into the buckets of surf fisherman for endless new discoveries. This fascination with the natural world continued into adulthood with numerous outdoors adventures while hiking, kayaking and boating in the wilderness surrounding Tallahassee.

Ann has worked in a variety of mediums throughout her life: ceramics, wood, photography and metal repousse. The textures and warmth of metal always bring her back for the excitement of experimenting with different techniques. Original designs are embossed into soft copper or brass with a variety of stylus tools. Both sides are worked to provide depth. The metal is then hardened with hammering. A fuming chamber provides endless patina options which can be followed with ink and acrylic finishes. Ann chose her metal work for entry into the exhibition.
