Program Description:

Join Gadsden Arts for an exciting opportunity! Twenty high school and undergraduate students from Leon and Gadsden counties will be selected to work with museum staff to learn about the museum, exhibitions, and art careers. Council members will create unique programs and enhance their resumés while learning about careers in the arts. These programs may include podcasts, zines, murals, websites, blogs, or videos. Participants will also create and exhibit personal works of art at the museum!

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS & DETAILS



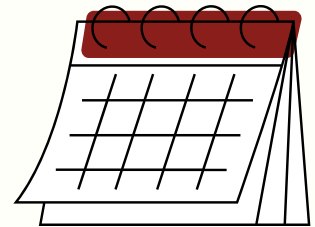
Requirements:

- Students must have an interest in art, music, or the cultural heritage field
- Internet & Zoom access
- Computer/tablet with video/audio capabilities
- Email address
- Availability on Tuesday afternoons (4:00-5:00pm)

Details:

Beginning in October, students will meet with GACM staff on Tuesdays via Zoom. Additionally, there will be Saturday field trips to see exhibitions, experience museums behind the scenes, and explore creative careers. Other program components include hands-on workshops, talks from curators and directors, and more! Once students are familiar with the major exhibition on view at GACM, they will work with staff to draft, budget, and execute their projects.

Applications open August and close in September each school year.
